According to the present Agrosor Loan policy, its loan size ranges from BDT 30,000 to BDT 10,00,000 as per the needs of the entrepreneurs. Apart from the graduated borrowers of Jagoron program, potential individual entrepreneurs also take loans for the enterprise. NGF provides need based capacity/skill development training to the entrepreneurs to help them manage their particular enterprise more competently
